

## Vendor Categories 2023

### Whitehouse Farmers Market

#### **Agricultural Producer:**

- Fruit, flowers, and/or vegetables that have been grown within 50 miles of the market location.
- Meat and processed meat products that are harvested from animals owned by and pastured on the vendors' property (including leased land) and processed at a USDA inspected facility.
- Eggs, cheese, yogurt, honey, soap or yarn from animals owned by the vendor and pastured on the vendors' property (including leased land). Food handlers certificate and NET Health permit may be required.
- Examples: Farmers, Ranchers, Beekeepers

#### **Value-Added:**

- Raw agricultural products grown or produced within 50 miles of the market location that have been enhanced to a higher market value or given a longer shelf life. Preference given to vendors who are the original producer of the primary ingredients or use market products. Organic and non-GMO ingredients are preferred. Commercial or home kitchen must be within 50 miles of the market location. Food handlers certificate and NET Health permit may be required.
- Examples: Baked Goods, Canned Goods, Herbal Products

#### **Prepared Food:**

- Freshly made food and drinks available for sale and immediate consumption on-site. These products may be hot or cold ready-to-eat foods or drinks. Products must use as many market products as available, preference given to those vendors who use local products. Organic and non-GMO ingredients are preferred. Commercial kitchens must be located within 50 miles of the market location. Food handlers certificate and NET Health permit are required.
- Examples: Food Trucks, Iced Beverages, Coffee

#### **Artisan:**

- Arts and/or crafts created by a local artisan located within 50 miles of the market location. Materials may be sourced from outside the area when integrated with other local products or created by a local artisan.
- Examples: Beauty and Skincare Products, Jewelry, Art, Woodworking, Home Decor

**Healthy Living:**

- Fitness, wellness and other vendor types that do not fit within the traditional boundaries of the vendor listings above. No physical products may be sold. Not a common vendor type, please check with the Vendor Coordinator before applying under this category.
- Examples: Health & Fitness Based Businesses, Chiropractic Care, Massage

**Nonprofit:**

- Non-profit, non-partisan organizations may apply for complimentary booth space based on availability. No fundraising allowed at markets and no sales activities allowed.
- Examples: Pet Adoption, Voter Registration (if bi-partisan), Charities, Youth Organizations
